1. **Largesse Sauvignon Blanc, Colombar, Cotes de Gascogne** £28.40 / bottle
South Western France, cool and vibrant, enticingly fruity and curiously moreish
2. **Petit Chablis, Burgundy, France** £48.90 / bottle
Aromas of white blossom mingled with citrus notes over a mineral base
3. **Pouilly- Fume, France** £47.00 / bottle
Green apple & melon, light and dry, sweet finish

ROSÉ

4. **Terras Lusas, Portugal** £29.50 / bottle
A vibrant wine with attractive aromas of red cherries, combined with exotic hints of lychee
5. **Ventoux Rose, Domaine de Fondreche, Rhone** £39.90 / bottle
A pale salmon-pink rose with fresh aromas of red berries (strawberries, raspberries), citrus zest and a hint of white flowers. On the palate, it's dry, crisp and vibrant with a refreshing acidity and a mineral finish
